



EVENTS ALCOHOL POLICY

The Hotel recognises the importance of holding a liquor license and in doing so accepts the responsibilities in strictly adhering to the liquor licensing laws outlined in the Intoxicating Liquor Act.

To ensure that alcohol is served responsibly the following rules will apply when alcohol is served:

- Persons under the age of 18 will not be served or provided with alcohol. Photographic ID will be required as proof of age for those who look under the age 23, e.g.: Passport, Garda Age Card, EU National ID Card
- Alcohol will not be served to persons who are intoxicated
- Persons who are intoxicated will not be permitted on to the premises
- Persons who are intoxicated will not be permitted to remain on the premises
- Persons under the age of 18 will not be permitted in the bar area after 9pm (Winter) and 10pm(Summer)
- Persons under the age of 15 will only be permitted in the bar area if accompanied by a Guardian
- No person may buy alcohol for those persons under 18 years of age
- Only alcohol purchased on the premises can be consumed on the premises
- There will be no house entertainment in the bar during 'drinking up' time
- In accordance with the Intoxicating Liquor Act, disorderly conduct will not be tolerated and guests may be asked to leave the venue
- Residents only in the residents bar - proof may be required
- Footwear must be worn at all times

Responsible Serving of Alcohol

- Staff are trained in Responsible Serving of Alcohol (RSA)
- Non & Low alcoholic drinks will be available at all times alcohol is served
- Staff will encourage guests to make alternative safe transport arrangements if they are considered to exceed the legal driving limit
- We would be happy to call a taxi for guests free of charge (service available at the Front Desk)
- Tap water will be provided free of charge from the bar
